

APPENDIX B: Condition of SSSI woodland

## Condition of SSSI woodland

Some of the SSSIs with woodland interest – in particular Rammer Cleugh - have areas that are not wooded, as sites can be designated for more than one interest. It has not been possible to separate this out. Juniper scrub is a feature of Lammer Law SSSI however the main reason for designation is other habitat. This Juniper Scrub habitat is nonetheless considered to be of High Nature Conservation Value. Further details can be found online here and here.

Woodhall Dean -	Unfavourable	Over grazing (deer)
Upland Oak Woodland	Declining
