

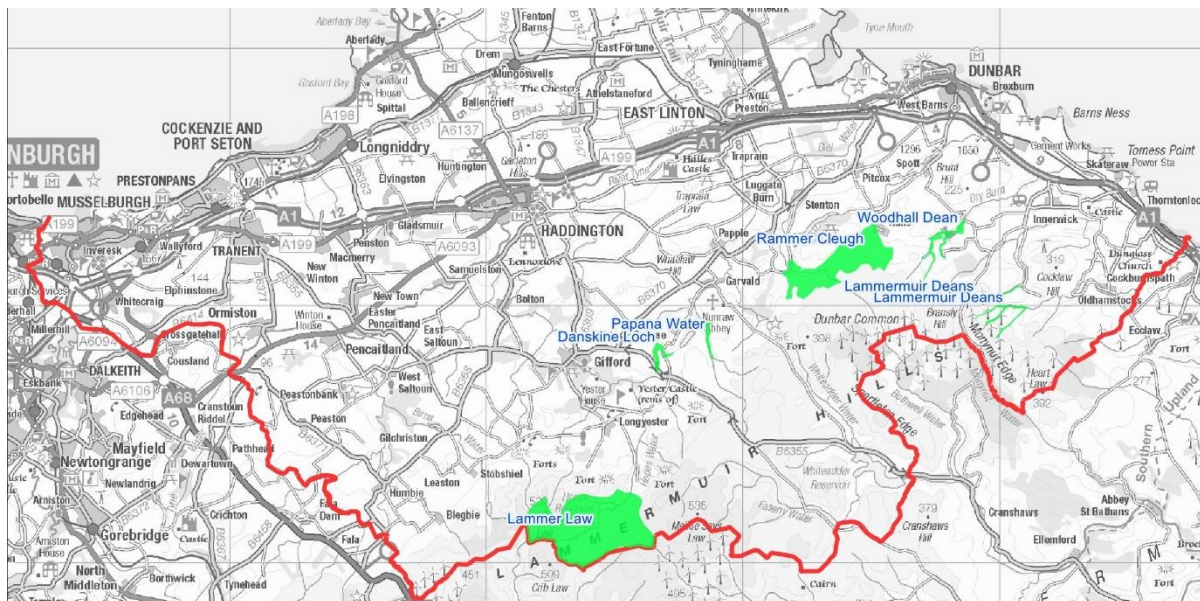

### APPENDIX B: Condition of SSSI woodland

## Condition of SSSI woodland

Some of the SSSIs with woodland interest – in particular Rammer Cleugh - have areas that are not wooded, as sites can be designated for more than one interest. It has not been possible to separate this out. Juniper scrub is a feature of Lammer Law SSSI however the main reason for designation is other habitat. This Juniper Scrub habitat is nonetheless considered to be of High Nature Conservation Value. Further details can be found online [here](#) and [here](#).

Danskine Loch – Fen Woodland	Unfavourable Declining ↓	Invasive species, no proactive management, water management
Lammer Law - Juniper scrub	Unfavourable Declining ↓	Burning, overgrazing
Lammermuir Deans – Upland mixed ash woodland	Unfavourable Recovering ↑	Overgrazing; deer and sheep
Papana Water - Upland Mixed Ash Woodland	Favourable Maintained →	Invasive species, under-grazing
Rammer Cleugh – Upland Oak Woodland	Unfavourable Recovering ↑	None
Woodhall Dean - Upland Oak Woodland	Unfavourable Declining ↓	Over grazing (deer)
