EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL (A199 OAK TREE, HADDINGTON) (STOPPING UP) ORDER 2026

TO 193/26

The EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 68(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having considered that the road specified in Part I of the Schedule to this order will become unnecessary, hereby make the following order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the “East Lothian Council (A199 Oak Tree, Haddington) (Stopping Up) Order 2026 and shall come into operation on xx xx 2026
2. The stopping up of roadside verge, part thereof, specified in Part I of the Schedule is hereby ordered.
3. Where there is, immediately before the date on which the said verge is stopped up under this Order, any apparatus belonging to any statutory undertakers, under, in, on, over along or across that length of road for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the said statutory undertakers shall after commencement of this order continue to have all rights in respect of the said apparatus as they had immediately before that date.
