**EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL (B6355 NEW WINTON)  
(40MPH BUFFER ZONE) ORDER 2023**

**TO 425/23**

EAST LoTHIAN COUNCIL in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 82(2), 83(2) and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (which Act so amended is hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Constable Police Scotland in accordance with Part III and V of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the “East Lothian Council (B6355) (40MPH Buffer Zone) Order 2023” and shall come into operation on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January Two Thousand and Twenty Four.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour in any direction on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. Revocation of Previous Orders: The following Orders are hereby revoked in their entirety:-
  - a. The East Lothian Council (B6355 New Winton) (40mph Speed Limit Order) Order 2000;

## SCHEDULE

Length of road where vehicles are prohibited from travelling in excess of 40mph:

B6355 New Winton – Both directions	To a point 300 metres or thereby Northwest of the 30MPH speed limit,
B6355 New Winton – Both directions	To a point 300 metres or thereby Southeast of the 30MPH speed limit,
