

## **EAST LINTON LIBRARY**

East Linton Library is part of a larger building (most of which has been converted into housing). The Library entrance and mechanical/electrical services are shared with the adjacent 'Day Centre'. The library offers community programmes/events/exhibitions, book lending, PC use, free Wi-Fi, school class visits, digital resources, local history resources and is a warm space within the local community. The Library is also an enquiry point for face-to-face East Lothian Council customer service enquiries and travel pass applications are processed and support provided for Blue Badge applications. The library is open 2 days per week. It is Category B listed by Historic Environment Scotland.
