JOHN MUIR HOUSE (INCL. FORMER COURT)

John Muir House serves as the headquarters for East Lothian Council. The building houses various council services and administrative offices. The former Sheriff Court building was purchased by East Lothian Council in December 2015. Original plans to accommodate Police Scotland were shelved and the space is now largely mothballed except for the ground floor Regent Room which is available for weddings by the Registrar. It is Category B listed by Historic Environment Scotland.
