NORTH BERWICK LIBRARY & COASTAL COMMUNITIES MUSEUM

A combined facility offering both library services and a free to enter museum. The library offers community programmes/events/exhibitions, book lending, PC use, free Wi-Fi, school and nursery class visits, book groups, customer enquiries, digital resources, local history resources and is a warm space within the local community. The Library is also an enquiry point for face-to-face East Lothian Council customer service enquiries and accepts payments for council services. Travel pass applications are processed and support provided for Blue Badge applications. The accommodation on the first floor is leased to the Coastal Communities Museum Trust, with specialist storage conditions/security measures for museum pieces on display. It is Category C listed by Historic Environment Scotland.
