

PORT SETON COMMUNITY CENTRE & LIBRARY

This building offers both library and community facilities. The community centre features a large multifunction hall, sports hall, meeting rooms, a café, sensory room, and a soft play area and hosts programs including fitness classes, youth clubs, toddler groups, messy play, pickleball, art sessions, line dancing, NHS sessions, over 60's lunch club, and social gatherings. Within the centre is a community pantry supporting families with food provision. The Adult Resource Centre is situated within the community centre providing support for adults with additional support needs to access provision and activities. The library offers community programmes/events/exhibitions, book lending, PC use, free Wi-Fi, school class visits, digital resources, local history resources and is a warm space within the local community. The Library is also an enquiry point for face-to-face East Lothian Council customer service enquiries and travel pass applications are processed and support provided for Blue Badge applications.
