TREVELYAN HALL

Trevelyan Hall was acquired by the District Council in 1975 and is located in Pencaitland. It offers two areas for hire: the main hall and an ante room. The facility is available for community groups, local residents, and various events. It also has three rooms upstairs that are not currently used due to their condition but could be adapted into usable spaces. It is Category C listed by Historic Environment Scotland.
