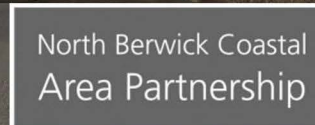

Are you interested in how the Town Centre works, how parking and traffic are organised, have ideas about how walking and cycling can be made easier, or the environment improved? Then come along and get involved in the charrette design consultation

A 'Charrette' design consultation is being run in North Berwick, launching on Tuesday 30 May and a series of design workshops from Thursday 1 June – Saturday 3 June 2017. Anyone can join in - you don't need any particular skills or expertise, and you're not expected to have 'all the answers'. A little time and enthusiasm is all you need to bring.

Through a series of discussions and workshops, local people will get the chance to work together to develop and test ideas that may make the town centre work better for everybody.

The aim is to build a consensus, using local knowledge and views from the whole community, on the best way to deliver change. This can feed into the Local Area Plan and Local Transportation Strategy.
