

Musselburgh's Active and Sustainable Travel Masterplan

Key Facts for Public Engagement:

- Project on behalf of East Lothian Council's Transportation team.
- East Lothian Council have a commitment to consider transport options to meet the demand for the planned future development around Musselburgh over the next 10-15 years.
- The Masterplan aims to improve Musselburgh for people walking and cycling and make these a practical choice for everyday journeys.
- A focus is on Strategic corridors into Musselburgh Town Centre and the key Transport Hubs.
- All routes should be safe and accessible for all ages and abilities and separate from busy and fast traffic.
- The current consultation includes a draft of the network to seek the views of the public. The routes designs shown are high-level ideas for what they could look like and will change in future through detailed consultation with those affected.
- Information and an online survey is available on the Councils consultation hub.
- This is a high level study at this stage, each route is a separate future project.
- We are looking for feedback on the network and each of the potential routes.
- None of this is approved or for construction and purely ideas we want the public feedback on and help shape.
- The next steps for the Masterplan would be to seek funding for the design and construction of individual routes: each of these routes and designs will be consulted in detail with local communities.
- Subject to funding, some of the less complex and sensitive routes could be constructed by 2020/21.
- An update to this consultation will be provided after it is complete.
